Position Title: International Trade Intern

Job Summary: The International Trade Intern will work with the Trade and International Affairs team at the Association for Accessible Medicines (AAM) to strengthen the advocacy capabilities of the association through research, expert identification, and the development of better tools for member engagement.

- Undertake research to demonstrate the impact of trade on the U.S. generic and biosimilar industry.

- Support member engagement through the dissemination of materials.
